## Principals Message:

### Student Peer Leaders Give Lessons on Clean Hands!



This past Wednesday February 5<sup>th</sup>, 8 Peer Leaders from Grade 7 & 8 were trained by Toronto Public Health Nurse Hillary to educate CWSA junior students on **Clean Hands**.

Gr 4 & 5 students learned that the most common way to spread germs is through our hands. They also learned that there are many types of germs (bacteria and viruses) and that these bacteria and viruses can cause illnesses such as cold and influenza.

Our peer leaders then educated students on washing hands and using hand sanitizer to reduce the spread of illness and disease. Leaders engaged students in a hand-on demonstration with ultra violet light to observe bio-germs on hands and reinforce the message of proper hand sanitation.

Inspired by their experience peer leaders' Jade, Elly and Zeyad approached our Caretaker Mike with a request for hand sanitizer, hand soap and paper towels in classrooms. I'm pleased to report that Mike quickly responded and 10 classrooms now have a hand soap dispenser by the sink. Hand sanitizer and paper towels are on the way. Our students learned a valuable lesson on working together to create solutions.

### Auditions

As you know, the Elementary Teachers' Federation of Ontario (ETFO) is currently in contract negotiations with the Government of Ontario and the Ontario Public School Boards' Association. The union has been taking part in a selected withdrawal of services since November 2019. As part of this ongoing job action, the Saturday, February 8 auditions are postponed. We will share more information about the February 22 and March 7 auditions soon.

We recognize that parents/guardians will have a number of questions and we will provide updates in the days and weeks ahead. We regret this disruption and appreciate your continued patience. We also remain hopeful that an agreement with ETFO can be achieved soon.

### Adults in the Building

## Toronto Public Health Clean Hands Messages

### How to Wash Your Hands

- Wet hands
- Apply soap
- Lather for 15 seconds. Rub palms, back of hands, fingertips, between fingers and under the nails
- Rinse well under running water
- Dry hands well with paper towel or hot air blower
- Turn taps off with paper towel, if available

### How to Use Hand Sanitizer

- Apply sanitizer (70 – 90% alcohol-based) only if hands are not visibly soiled
- Rub hands together
- Work sanitizer between fingers, palms, back of hands, fingertips, under the nails
- Rub hands until dry
