

Principals Message: Circles in the Classroom

One of the strategies CWSA teachers are using to build community in the classroom are Circles. Teachers know building strong relationship with students helps all students feel welcome. Students quickly take to the concept of circles. This week I had the opportunity to visit with Ms.



Why are circles important? (use one word to share how you're feeling)

- "You can empathize with others"
- "You can understand when someone needs more space cause they're tired"
- "If someone is acting different than usual you understand"
- "You can cheer someone up"

I'm always pleasantly surprised by how much children have to say when given the opportunity to communicate with others about things that matter to them. Students felt sharing challenges were important part of community:

- "I'm not alone"
- "I can support someone"
- "If I went through the same thing I can share with someone else"
- "You can offer solutions or strategies if you had that problem"

The Grade 4s brainstormed some strategies to help other CWSA students manage stress:

- "Talk to your parents they can support you."
- "Tell your parents how you feel they may not know."
- "Eat something maybe your tired and need energy."
- "Breathe in and out."
- "Count out loud or in your head."

Thank-you for class 4.1 for sharing! At CWSA, teachers and students will continue to use circles to build healthy relationships in our classes and in our school.
