Arts Express Who is Arts Express?

Arts Express[™] was established in 1995 and incorporated in 1998. Today, as a social enterprise, Arts Express reaches tens of thousands of students each year through arts classes, camps and workshops in hundreds of schools across the GTA, York, Peel, Durham, Halton, and Ottawa regions.

Grade 5s said **Bye-Bye Bullies** through art and drama activities. While the Grade 4s got a taste of **Hip Hop Dance** as they declared the are way too cool to be bullies. Finally, all our Grade 6 tackled the topic of Bullying head on as students participated in an animated storytelling experience of **My Secret Bully** where student learned to face their fear and reclaim their power from the bully who uses name-calling, humiliation and exclusion to target others.

CWSA Core Teachers will continue to use community **Circles** in core classes to build healthy relationships and help students to work through challenges using appropriate language and behavior understanding that when we make mistakes we can use our words to talk through and learn from each situation.

Please reinforce with your children the importance of standing up against behavior that tries to hurt or exclude others. We can all be peace makers, allies and friends.
