"School council is an ADVISORY group" (that) "provides advice to the school principal and/or school board on any matter." -Education Act Reg. 612/3.8; 612/20

On **November 25**, 2019, @ 7pm, **School Council Elections** will be held for those parents interested in becoming voting members of the school council. In order to be eligible, one must: be a parent and/or caregiver of a child currently enrolled at Claude Watson School of the Arts; and is properly nominated (self-nominations are accepted).

Council meets several times each year. Meetings are an opportunity for the principal to bring forth issues occurring at the school that could benefit from parent input and/or support. Parents also put forth issues and ideas for discussion and possibly problem-solving. Fundraising and deciding how to spend fund-raised dollars are examples an oft-discussed item at meetings.

If you are interested in joining council this year (or would like to nominate another

parent/caregiver), please submit a completed nomination form to the school office **by 4 pm on Thursday, November 21st**. Nominations can also be made in person at the council meeting on **Monday, November 25, at 7 pm** which will held in the multi-purpose room at CWSA. Dear Parent/Guardian:

School Year 2019-2020

To identify children with oral health problems, a screening program is offered by Toronto Public Health (T.P.H) to students in accordance with the Ontario Ministry of Health requirements for mandatory health programs. The screening is an assessment by an oral health staff member using a separate sterilized mouth mirror for each child. The oral health staff member will assess the need for topical fluoride, scaling, sealant and any other obvious dental needs.

As a follow up to the screening, only parents whose children were screened will be notified and a note to that effect will be sent home with their child/ren for your information and action. You may also receive a phone call from T.P.H. dental staff to assist you in accessing care.

Please be advised that this screening assessment does not replace the dental examination done by a dentist.

The screening date for your child/ren's school has been scheduled for:

Dec 3-5, 2019

If you do not wish your child/ren to be screened, please inform the school staff and the classroom teacher.
